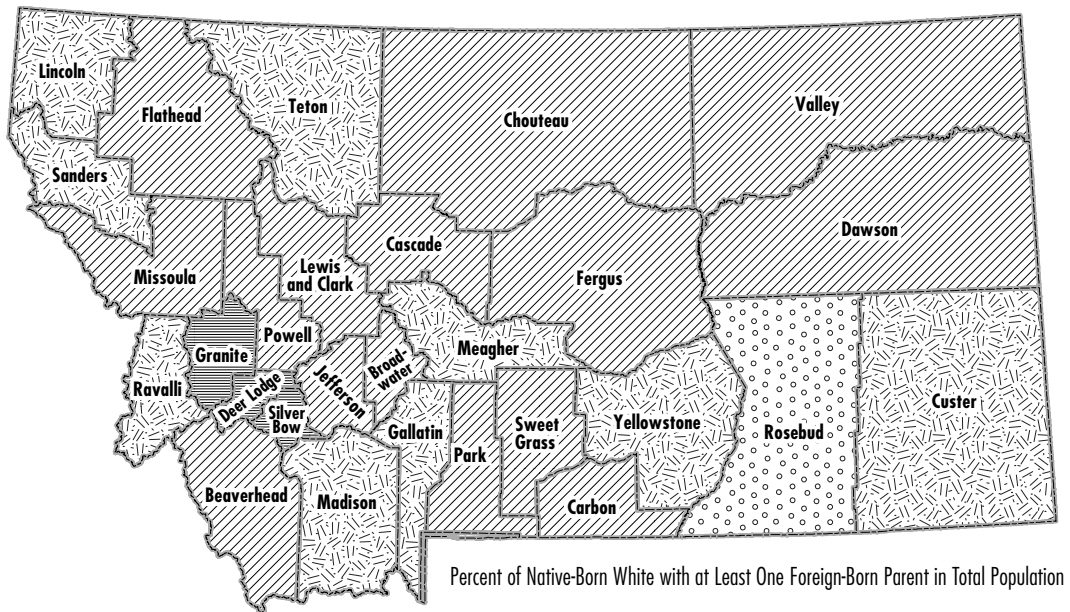
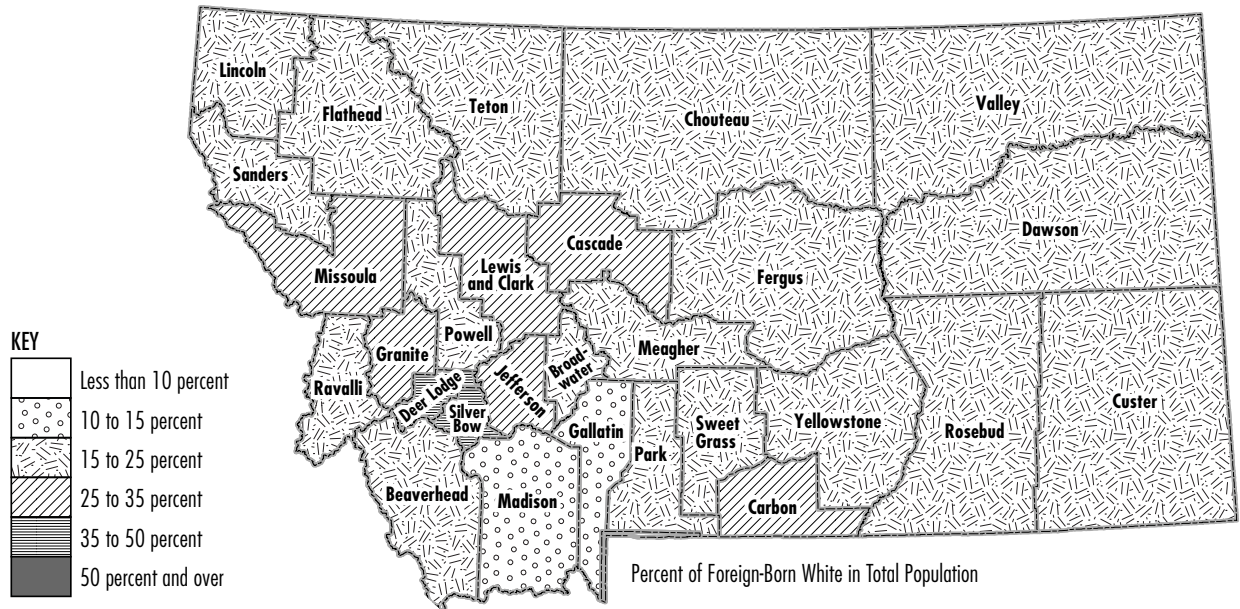


CHAPTER 15 / Comparing Information on Maps
